## **TOURISM STATISTICAL RELEASE JANUARY-2025**

Issued date – 13.02.2025

#### **TOURISM STATISTICS**

Zanzibar recorded **84,069** international visitors in January 2025, an increase of **14.4** percent compared with **73,468** visitors in January 2024 and a decrease of **8.2** percent compared with **91,611** visitors recorded in the preceding month (December 2024).

European tourists dominated the market by accounting for **73.9** percent of the total visitors in January 2025. Country-wise, the Italians dominated the Tourism market by accounting for **13.9** percent of all visitors entered in January 2025, followed by Polish (**9.7** percent) while New Zealand recorded less than one percent (**0.2%**), the least. Other performances are as shown in (**Table 1**).




Figure 1: International Visitors by Entry Points, January 2025

The data shows that in January 2025, **75,767** visitors, equivalent to **90.1** percent of the total visitors, entered through the Airport. **65,658** visitors entered by international flights and **10,109** by domestic flights. The remaining **8,302** visitors entered through the seaport, of whom **3** were entered by cruise ship and **8,299** were by sea ferry from Tanzania Mainland, as shown in **Figure 1** and **Table 2**.

Information on the purpose of visit (**Table 3**) shows that in January 2025, **83,690** visitors equivalent to **99.5** percent, came for holidays, **0.4** percent for visiting friends and relatives, and **0.1** percent for other purposes.




Figure 2: International Visitors by Sex, January 2025

Table 4 and Figure 2 show that 40,229 visitors (47.9 percent) were male and 43,840 (52.1 percent) were female. The number of males and females decreased by 0.9 and 14.1 percent, respectively, compared with December 2024.




Figure 3: International Visitors by Categorized Age, January 2025

The ages of the visitors were categorized into three broad groups: those younger than 15 years who are regarded as children, those 15 to 64 years who are regarded as working age population, and those 65 years and older are considered retirees. The overall results show that **4,536** visitors (**5.4** percent) visitors were aged less than 15 years, **70,476** visitors (**83.8** percent) were aged 15 to 64 years, and **9,057** visitors (**10.8** percent) were aged 65 years and older (**Figure 3 & Table 5**).




Figure 4: Visitors Arrival from Emerging Markets, January 2025 and January 2024

The number of visitors from emerging markets in January 2025 (Poland, India, Russia, Israel, China, and Ukraine) increased by **11.2** percent compared with the number of visitors recorded in January 2024. Other performances are shown in (**Figure 4 & Annex I**).

Table 6 shows that a higher percentage of visitors (26.2 percent) stayed in the country for seven days in January 2025. Visitors' average intended length of stay in January 2025 was eight (8) days.

A total of **913,911** bed spaces were available in January 2025. Estimates of **698,762** beds were sold during January 2025, representing a bed occupancy rate of **76.5** percent (**Table 7**).

#### Glossary

Information on the number of visitors, their nationality, and age distribution are among the important economic indicators. The tourism industry has contributed significantly to Zanzibar's economy and it is therefore necessary that such information is made available promptly. This report provides detailed information on the age and sex distribution; mode of travel; nationality and regional distribution; and purpose of travel of visitors are also provided. The information was captured using the Arrival Declaration Cards on visitors who entered Zanzibar through both the airport and sea ports.

#### **Definition and Concepts**

**Tourist:** refers to any person traveling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited. (According to the United Nations World Tourism Organization -UNWTO)

**Visitor: refers** to any person traveling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

This release categories visitors into four groups in terms of mode of transport:

- (i) International flight comprising visitors entering the country directly from abroad;
- (ii) Domestic flight comprising of visitors entering Zanzibar via Tanzania Mainland;
- (iii) Cruise ship comprising of visitors (**excursionists**) entered Zanzibar by cruise ship; and
- (iv) Sea ferries comprising visitors entered Zanzibar by using local sea boats.
