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ZANZIBAR CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (ZCPI) FOR FEBRUARY 2025

ANNUAL HEADLINE INFLATION RATE RECORDED 4.81 PERCENT

The Inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Zanzibar for the 12 months to February 2025 decreased to 4.81 percent from 5.27 percent registered in January 2025. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate decrease to 6.37 percent in February 2025 compared to 7.21 percent in January 2025. The overall Index increased to 114.80 in February 2025 compared to 109.53 recorded in February 2024 (Table 1).

ANNUAL FOOD AND NON-FOOD INFLATION RATES

Annual Inflation Rate for food decreased to 5.78 percent for the year ended February 2025 compared to 6.64 percent recorded for the year ended January 2025. The overall index for food increased to 123.58 in February 2025 from 116.83 recorded in February 2024, while Annual inflation rate for non-food decrease to 4.08 percent in February 2025 compared to 4.22 percent in January 2025, overall index for non-food increased to 108.83 in February 2025 compared to 104.56 in February 2024, (Table 2). Products contribute to decrease annual inflation rate were Thailand Rice 7.1%, Mbeya Rice 10.3%, Basmat Rice 1.2%, Maize Flour 10.6%, Flat Bread 3.7%, Yellow Cooking Bananas 11.0%, Green Cooking Bananas 7.7%, Brown Sugar and White Sugar 19.0% and 19.4% respectively, Diesel 5.1% and Petrol 3.9% (Table 3).

MONTHLY HEADLINE INFLATION IN FEBRUARY 2025

During February 2025 the monthly headline inflation rate decreased to negative 0.04 percent compared to 1.86 percent recorded for the month ended January 2025. The monthly Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate for the month ended February 2025 decreased to negative 0.12 percent compared to 1.89 percent for the month ended January 2025 (**Table 1**).

The products that contribute monthly inflation rate to decrease are Thailand rice 2.7%, Jasmin rice 2.2%, Maize Flour 3.3%, Sunflower Cooking Oils 0.1%, Yellow Cooking Banana 3.0%, Green Cooking Banana 8.4%, Brown Sugar and White Sugar 2,7% and 2.4% respectively, (Table 3).

Chart 1: Zanzibar Inflation Rate from February 2023 – February 2025





Chart 2: Zanzibar Inflation Rate for Food, Nonfood and All Items from February 2024 – February 2025



Explanatory Note

The CPI measures the average percentage changes over time (between two time periods) in the prices of a "basket" of consumer goods and services acquired by households (the market basket) in Zanzibar. The Zanzibar CPI covers prices of 398 items collected in 670 outlets in Unguja and Pemba urban Centers. The goods and services included in the ZCPI basket are classified according to the UN COICOP (Classification of Individual Consumption According by Purpose) with 13 divisions.

The ZCPI weights are based on both monetary and non-momentary expenditures relating to consumption for households in Zanzibar for the 2019/20 Household Budget Survey (HBS). The weight is based on expenditures of both urban and rural households. Both base price and index has reference period of July 2022.

The computation of indices at elementary level based on geometric mean of the price relative while at higher level the Laspeyres formula was used to compute the aggregate indices.
