

STATISTICAL RELEASE ZANZIBAR ROAD ACCIDENTS AND OFFENCES STATISTICS FOR JULY-2018

No: 7



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Introduction

This is a monthly release which provides summary of statistics from two crime statistics areas namely road accidents and traffic offences. These statistics are released by geographical disaggregation, category and differentiated by gender.

Roads accidents statistics provide information on number of accidents occurred, type of victim and status of the victim after the accident. While, traffic offences statistics provide information about the road traffic offenses classified into ten broad categories.

Objective

The objective of the release is to provide timely road accidents and traffic offences information in Zanzibar. This information is useful for planners, policy makers and decision makers.

1. Road Accidents

A total of 31 accidents was reported in July, 2018 that involved 59 victims of whom 54 were males and 5 were females. Among the victims, 40 were injured and 19 died. Mjini and Magharibi B districts reported the highest number of accidents (Six accidents) followed by, Magharibi A district (five accidents), while no accidents were reported in Kati and Mkoani districts. Mjini district reported the highest number of victims (19 victims) even though there were Six accidents. There is no relationship between the number of accidents occurred and victims.

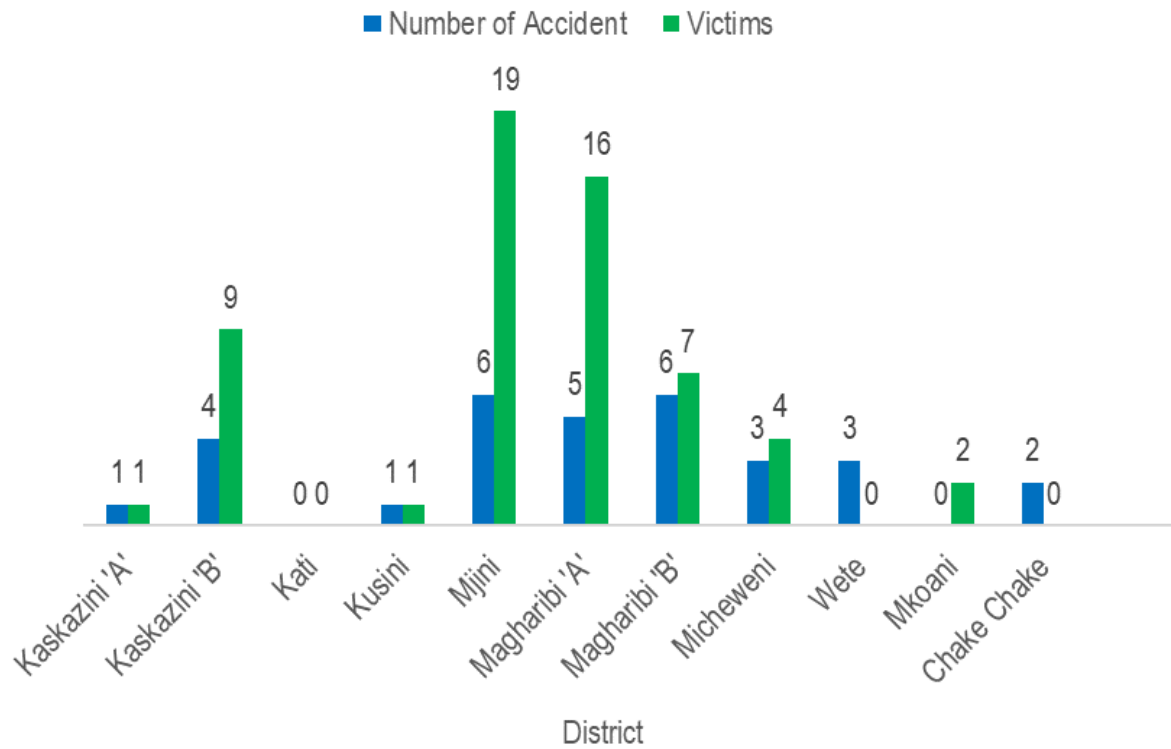


Figure 1.2: Number of Victims of Accidents, July 2018

Among the victims of the road accidents (died/injured), most of them were pedestrians (23) followed by, cyclists (17), passengers (16) and drivers (3) (Table 1.1, Table 1.2, Figure 1.1 and Figure 1.2).

The total number of accidents reported increased to 31 in July, 2018 from 27 accidents reported in June, 2018 while the number of victims decreased (18.1 percent) to 59 in July, 2018 from 72 in June, 2018 (Table 1.3).

2. Traffic Offences

A total of 2,985 traffic offences was reported in June, 2018 of which 2,983 offences were committed by males and 2 by females. Dangerous loads and passengers' (845 offences) were highly reported followed by, non- compliance with guidelines and traffic regulations offences (666 offences), failure to wear uniforms and badges for conductor and driver at passenger car (571 offences) driving without license, Insurance and road license (334 offences) and driving without helmet. (326 offences). The five accounts for more than three quarters (91.9 percent) of all offences. The same feature was observed in previous month.

Magharibi B district committed more offences were 608 (20.4 percent) compared with other districts. While Kusini reported the least number of offences were 37 offences (1.2 percent) with increase in its frequencies. The districts of Mjini Magharibi shared 47.6 percent of all offences suggesting that the region continues to be the center of road offences. Kati, Wete and Kaskazini A districts were more likely to commit offences of non- compliance with guidelines and traffic regulations offences, while all districts in Mjini Magharibi committed more of failure to wear uniforms and badges for conductor and driver at passenger car offences, dangerous loads and passengers 'offences, driving without licenses and other road permit offences and driving without helmet, whereby Kati and Kaskazini B districts more likely to dangerous loads and passengers' offences. However, Wete district more likely to dangerous driving offences and mechanical defect offences (Table 2.1 and 2.2).

A total number of offences reported July in 2018 increased to 2,985 from 2,651 reported on June, 2018 which indicates increasing of 12.6 percent (Table 2.2)

Figure 1.1: Number of Accident and Victims by District, July 2018

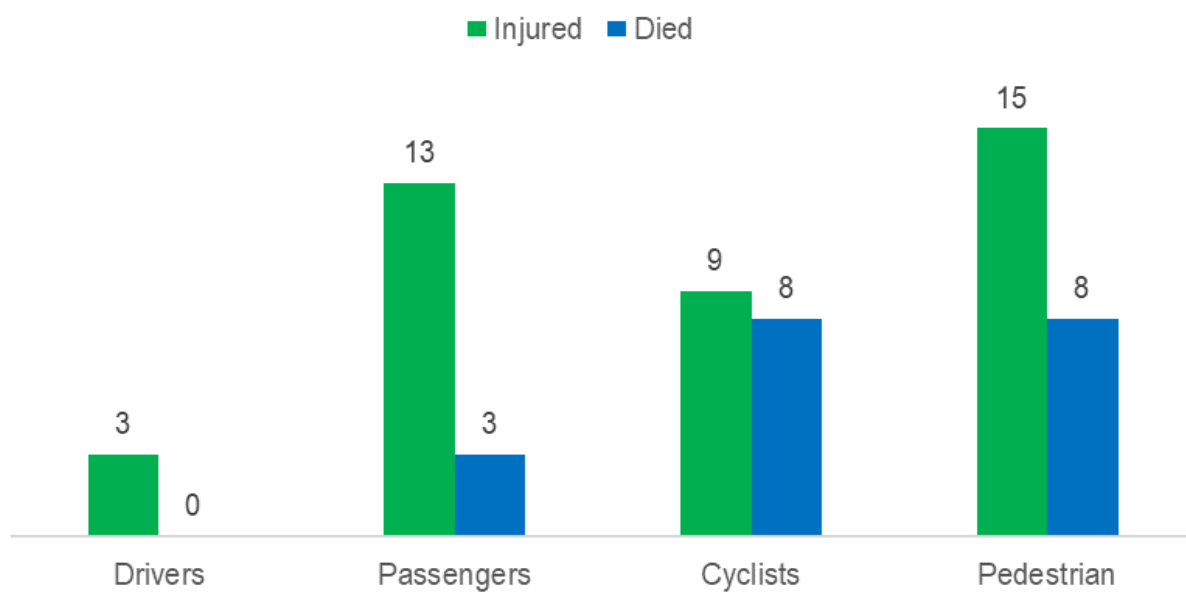

Figure 2.1: Number of Offences by Type, July 2018

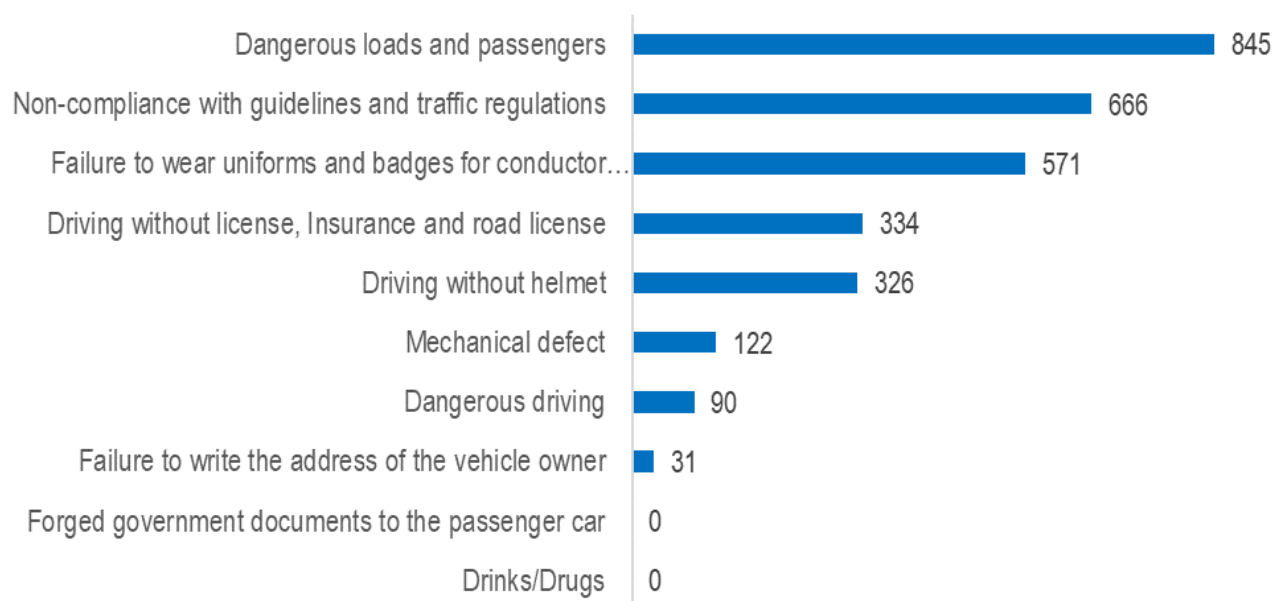


Figure 2.2: Number of Offences by Districts, July 2018

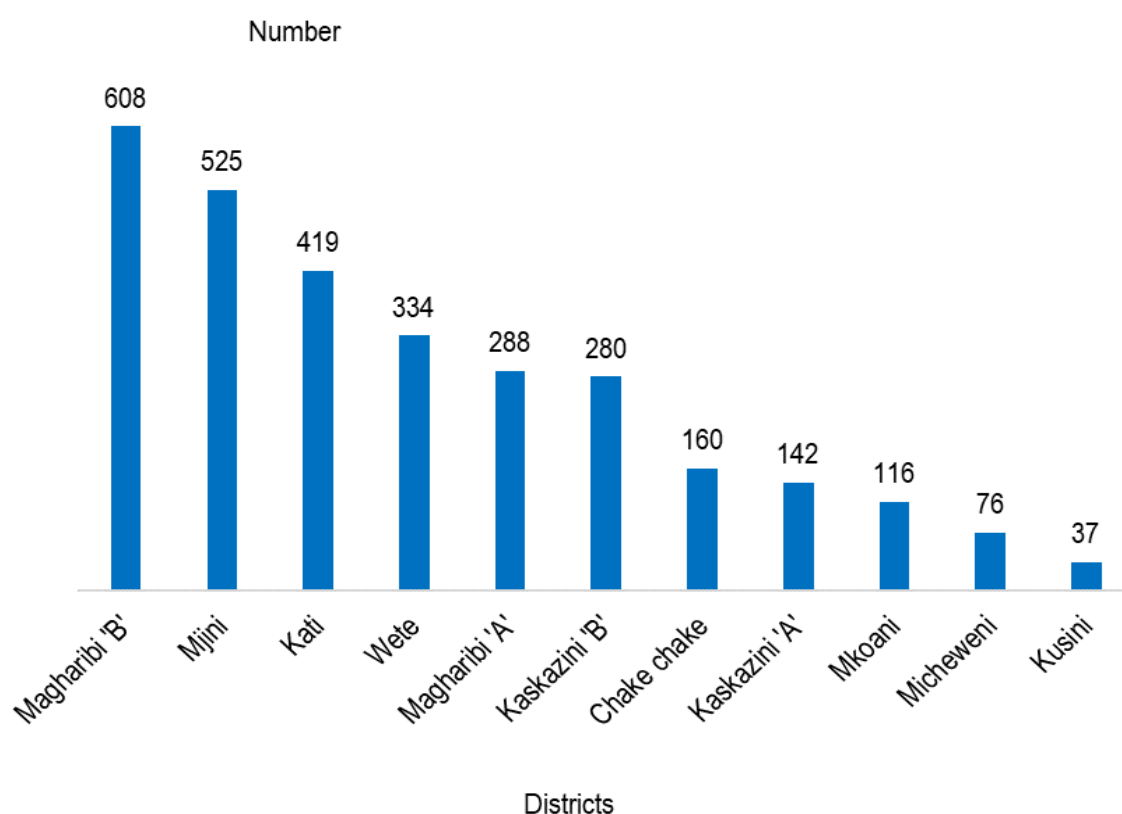

Explanatory Note

Roads are primary mean of transportation. These provide human access to different places. Many people's use road for different means of transport. Some of them use vehicle, bicycle and others walk.

A road accident refers to any accident involving at least one road vehicle, occurring on a road open to public circulation, and in which at least one person is injured or killed. According to Penal Act no. 6/2004 Act to repeal the Penal Decree, chapter 13 of the law of Zanzibar limitation as time to death is defined as Killed persons are accident victims who die immediately or within 366 days following the accident. Injured persons are accident victims having suffered trauma requiring medical treatment with or without hospitalization.

An offence is a crime that breaks a particular law and requires a particular punishment. Road accidents are caused by various human offenses. Many mistakes that make his appearance seem to be minor but his impact becomes great. As a result, people getting disabilities or dying
