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ZANZIBAR CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (ZCPI) FOR MAY 2025

ANNUAL HEADLINE INFLATION RATE RECORDED 4.16 PERCENT

The Inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Zanzibar for the 12 months to May 2025 decreased to 4.16 percent from 4.25 percent registered in April 2025. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate decrease to 4.52 percent in May 2025 compared to 4.72 percent in April 2025. The overall Index increased to 116.07 in May 2025 compared to 111.44 recorded in May 2024 (Table 1).

ANNUAL FOOD AND NON-FOOD INFLATION RATES

Annual Inflation Rate for food decreased to 3.91 percent for the year ended May 2025 compared to 4.10 percent recorded for the year ended April 2025. The overall index for food increased to 125.76 in May 2025 from 121.03 recorded in May 2024, while Annual inflation rate for non-food slightly decrease to 4.35 percent in May 2025 compared to 4.37 percent in April 2025, overall index for non-food increased to 109.48 in May 2025 compared to 104.92 in May 2024, (Table 2). Products contribute to decrease annual inflation rate were Thailand Rice 11.05%, Mbeya Rice 13.30%, Basmat Rice 1.16%, Jasmin Rice 9.90%, Wheat Flour 1.03%, Maize Flour 9.73%, Fish 7.72%, Yellow Cooking Banana 10.64%, Green Cooking Banana 7.37%, Brown Sugar 19.23%, White Sugar 17.92% and Petrol 6.69% (Table 3).

MONTHLY HEADLINE INFLATION IN MAY 2025

During May 2025 the monthly headline inflation rate decreased to negative 0.07 percent compared to 1.02 percent recorded for the month ended April 2025. The monthly Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate for the month ended May 2025 decreased to 0.04 percent compared to 1.64 percent for the month ended April 2025 (**Table 1**).

The products that contribute monthly inflation rate to decrease are Thailand Rice 3.69%, Jasmin Rice 0.38%, Sunflower Oil 0.36%, Yellow Cooking Banana 0.26%, Green Cooking Banana 4.34%, Brown Sugar 2.56%, White 2.55 and Diesel 0.09% (Table3).



Explanatory Note

The CPI measures the average percentage changes over time (between two time periods) in the prices of a "basket" of consumer goods and services acquired by households (the market basket) in Zanzibar. The Zanzibar CPI covers prices of 398 items collected in 670 outlets in Unguja and Pemba urban Centers. The goods and services included in the ZCPI basket are classified according to the UN COICOP (Classification of Individual Consumption According by Purpose) with 13 divisions.

The ZCPI weights are based on both monetary and non-momentary expenditures relating to consumption for households in Zanzibar for the 2019/20 Household Budget Survey (HBS). The weight is based on expenditures of both urban and rural households. Both base price and index has reference period of July 2022.

The computation of indices at elementary level based on geometric mean of the price relative while at higher level the Laspeyres formula was used to compute the aggregate indices.
