ZANZIBAR CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (ZCPI) FOR DECEMBER 2026

ANNUAL HEADLINE INFLATION RATE RECORDED 4.25 PERCENT

The Inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Zanzibar for the 12 months to January 2026 increased to 4.25 percent from 3.81 percent registered in December 2025. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate increased to 9.05 percent in January 2026 compared to 6.18 percent in December 2025. The overall Index increased to 119.74 in January 2026 compared to 114.86 recorded in January 2025 (Table 1).

ANNUAL FOOD AND NON-FOOD INFLATION RATES

Annual Inflation Rate for food increased to 9.18 percent for the year ended January 2026 compared to 5.44 percent recorded for the year ended December 2025. The overall index for food increased to 135.09 in January 2026 from 123.73 recorded in January 2025, while Annual inflation rate for non-food decreased to 0.44 percent in January 2026 compared to 2.54 percent in December 2025, overall index for non-food increased to 109.29 in January 2026 compared to 108.81 in January 2025, (Table 2). Products contribute to increase annual inflation rate were Mbeya Rice 8.17%, Maize Flour 1.08%, Flat bread 3.79%, Fish 19.98%, Sunflower Cooking Oil 1.52%, Edible cooking Oil (OKI) 2.52%, Yellow Cooking Banana 13.92%, Green Cooking Banana 21.05%, Gas in Cylinder 0.32% and Petrol 1.37% (Table 3).

MONTHLY HEADLINE INFLATION IN JANUARY 2026

During January 2026 the monthly headline inflation rate increased to 2.30 percent compared to 0.82 percent recorded for the month ended December 2025. The monthly Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate for the month ended January 2026 increased to 4.82 percent compared to 2.04 percent for the month ended December 2025 (Table 1).

The products that contribute to increase monthly inflation rate are Thailand Rice 0.91%, Mbeya Rice 0.49%, Wheat Flour 1.25%, Maize Flour 3.44%, Fish 7.35%, Edible Cooking Oils (OKI) 0.41%, Green Cooking Banana 9.18% and Brown Sugar 0.23% (Table3).

Chart 1: Zanzibar Inflation Rate from January 2024 – January 2026





Chart 2: Zanzibar Inflation Rate for Food, Nonfood and All Items from January 2025 – January 2026



Explanatory Note

The CPI measures the average percentage changes over time (between two time periods) in the prices of a “basket” of consumer goods and services acquired by households (the market basket) in Zanzibar. The Zanzibar CPI covers prices of 398 items collected in 670 outlets in Unguja and Pemba urban Centers. The goods and services included in the ZCPI basket are classified according to the UN COICOP (Classification of Individual Consumption According by Purpose) with 13 divisions.

The ZCPI weights are based on both monetary and non-momentary expenditures relating to consumption for households in Zanzibar for the 2019/20 Household Budget Survey (HBS). The weight is based on expenditures of both urban and rural households. Both base price and index has reference period of July 2022.

The computation of indices at elementary level based on geometric mean of the price relative while at higher level the Laspeyres formula was used to compute the aggregate indices.
