

# Zanzibar Quarterly Gross Domestic Product



**First Quarter 2026**

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## **Abstract**

This report presents Zanzibar's Quarterly Gross Domestic Product (GDP) estimates for the first quarter of 2026, compiled using the newly rebased National Accounts series with 2019 as the base year, replacing the previous 2015 base year. The rebasing exercise was undertaken to ensure that the National Accounts reflect the current structure of Zanzibar's economy, incorporate updated benchmark information and data sources, and improve the accuracy, reliability, and relevance of macroeconomic statistics in line with international standards and best practices.

The rebased National Accounts incorporate benchmark data from the 2019 Supply and Use Table (SUT), adopt the recommendations of the 2008 System of National Accounts (SNA 2008), and align industry classifications with the International Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (ISIC Rev. 4). These methodological improvements provide a more comprehensive and accurate representation of economic activity and strengthen the international comparability of Zanzibar's GDP estimates. Furthermore, the quarterly GDP series has been benchmarked to the revised annual GDP levels resulting from the rebasing exercise, ensuring consistency between annual and quarterly estimates.

The introduction of the rebased GDP estimates marks an important milestone in the compilation and dissemination of Zanzibar's National Accounts statistics. As a result of the methodological enhancements and revisions to source data, the estimates presented in this report may not be directly comparable with those previously published under the former 2015 base year series.

During the first quarter of 2026, real GDP at constant 2019 prices was estimated at TZS 1,872 billion, representing a year-on-year incline of 6.7 percent. At current prices, nominal GDP increased by 8.6 percent compared with the corresponding quarter of 2025. The report provides an overview of economic developments during the quarter, highlighting GDP growth trends and the performance of major economic sectors.

The findings presented in this report provide policymakers, planners, investors, researchers, development partners, and other stakeholders with timely and reliable information on the state of Zanzibar's economy. The report establishes a new statistical benchmark for monitoring short-term economic performance and supports evidence-based planning, policy formulation, and the assessment of progress towards Zanzibar's development objectives.

## Overview

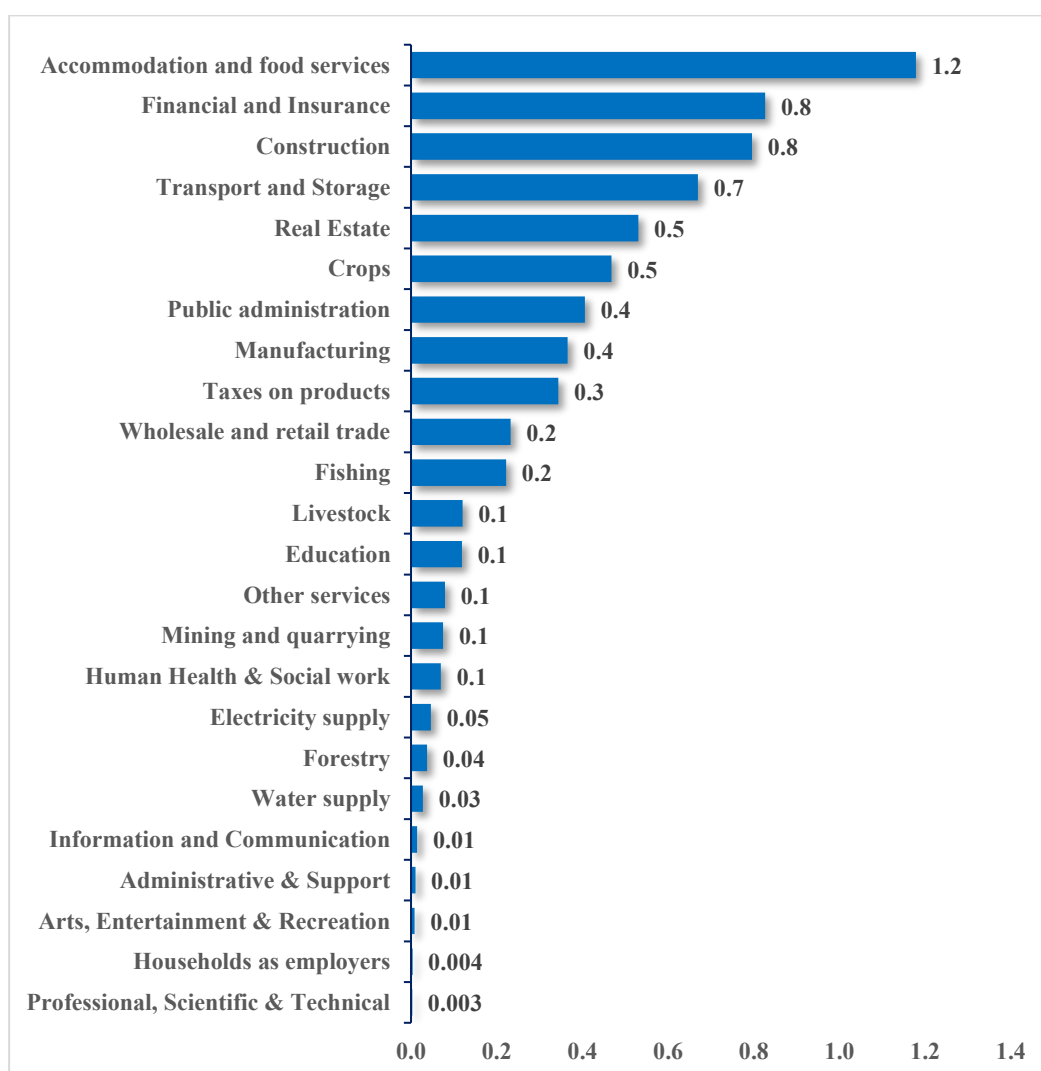
Zanzibar's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) in the first quarter of 2026 in volume terms increased by **6.7 percent** compared with corresponding quarter (**5.5 percent**) of 2025. The analysis of GDP growth by economic activity shows that Accommodation and Food Service Activities were the main contributors to overall GDP growth during the quarter, contributing 1.2 percentage points. This was followed by Construction and Financial and Insurance Activities, each contributing 0.8 percentage points, while Transport and Storage contributed 0.7 percentage points.

Other notable contributions came from Real Estate Activities and Crop Production, each contributing 0.5 percentage points. Public Administration and Manufacturing each contributed 0.4 percentage points, while Taxes on Products contributed 0.3 percentage points. Wholesale and Retail Trade and Fishing each contributed 0.2 percentage points as well as Livestock, Education, Other Services, Mining and Quarrying Human Health and social work each contributed 0.1 Percentage point.

Relatively small contributions were recorded in Professional Scientific and Technical (0.003 percentage points), Household as employers (0.004 percentage points) as well as Arts Entertainment and Recreation, Administrative and support and Information and Communication each contributed 0.01 percentage points (Figure 1).

Overall, the results indicate that growth in GDP during this quarter was mainly driven by service-related activities, particularly accommodation and food services, Construction and Financial and Insurance activities.

## Analysis of GDP Broad Sector at Current and Constant Price

### GDP at Current Price Broad Sector

For analytical purposes, Zanzibar's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is classified into four broad sectors: the Primary Sector (Agriculture), the Secondary Sector (Industry), the Tertiary Sector (Services), and Taxes on products.

**Figure 2: Share of Main Sector at Current Price in (%), Q1 2026**

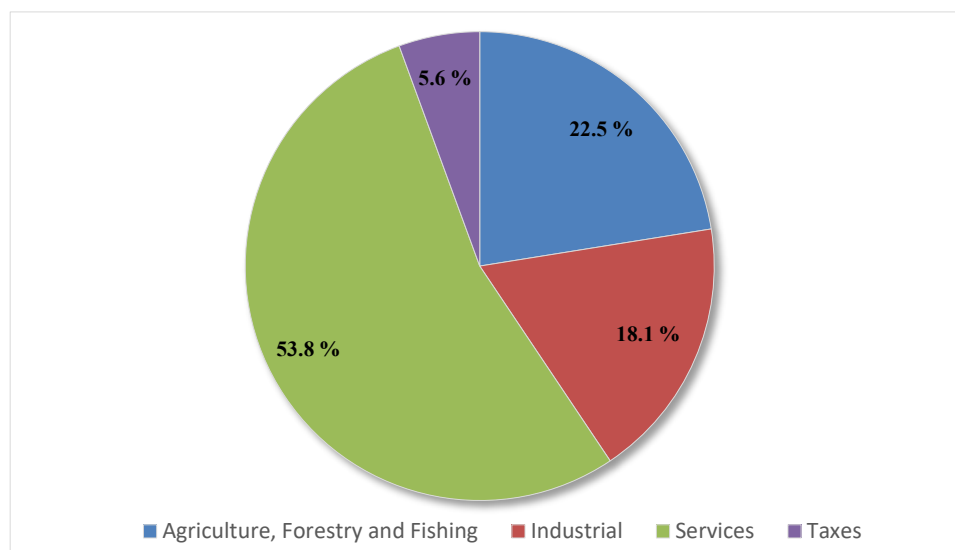


Figure 2 shows the composition of GDP at current prices for the year 2026, categorized into four main broad sectors of the economy, Primary Sector (Agriculture sector), Secondary Sector (Industry Sector) and Tertiary Sector (Services Sector) and Taxes on products.

The services sector remained the largest contributor to the economy, accounting for 53.8 percent of total GDP. This indicates that the economy continues to be predominantly driven by service-related activities, highlighting the sector's significant role in overall economic performance. The Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing sector accounted for 22.5 percent of total GDP, making it the second-largest contributor and underscoring the continued importance of primary activities to the economy. The industrial sector contributed 18.1 percent, reflecting its important, though comparatively smaller, role in economic output. Meanwhile, taxes accounted for 5.6 percent of total GDP, representing the smallest share among the four components. Overall, the results indicate that the economy is largely service-oriented, while agriculture remains a key productive sector and industrial activities continue to make a notable contribution to GDP.

**Growth of Main Sectors at Constant Prices**

**Agricultural sector** increased by 6.2 percent due to an increase in yields of crops such as paddies, cassava, banana etc. and vegetables and fruits like watermelons and tomatoes, as well as an increase in fishery production.

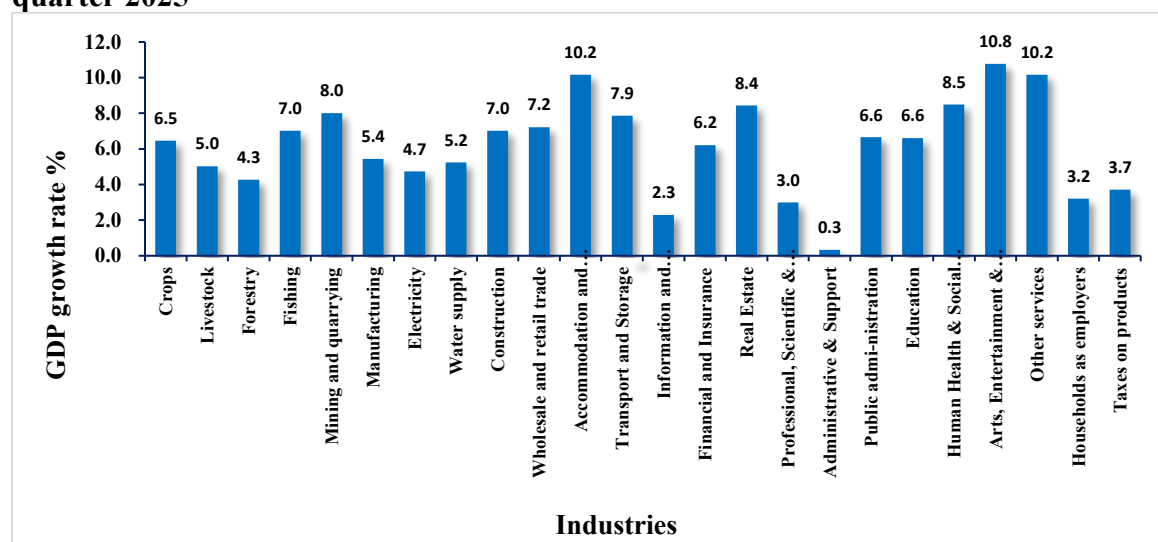
**The Industrial sector** also increased by 6.4 percent. This growth was primarily due to increases in mining and quarrying production and Construction Activities.

**The Service sector** grew by 7.3 percent compared with corresponding quarter, 2025. This growth came from crucial sectors including Arts, Entertainment & Recreation, Accommodation and Food Services, Other Services, Human Health & Social work, Real Estate, Transport and Storage, Wholesale and retail trade, Public Administration, Education, as well as Financial and Insurance Activities.

The results show that based on constant price, the GDP growth by economic activity indicates mixed performance across industries during this quarter. The highest growth rates were recorded in Arts, Entertainment and Recreation (10.8 percent), followed by Accommodation and Food Service Activities (10.2 percent), reflecting an increase in tourist arrivals. Other Services also grew by 10.2 percent. Strong growth was further observed in Human Health and Social Work Activities (8.5 percent), Real Estate Activities (8.4 percent), Mining and Quarrying (8.0 percent), Transport and Storage (7.9 percent), Wholesale and Retail Trade (7.2 percent), while both Construction and Fishing recorded a growth rate of 7.0 percent. Public Administration and Education each grew by 6.6 percent, followed by Crop Production (6.5 percent), Manufacturing (5.4 percent) and Water Supply (5.2 percent).

On the other hand, relatively lower growth rates were recorded in Administrative and Support Service Activities (0.3 percent), Information and Communication (2.3 percent), and Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities (3.0 percent), Figure 2).

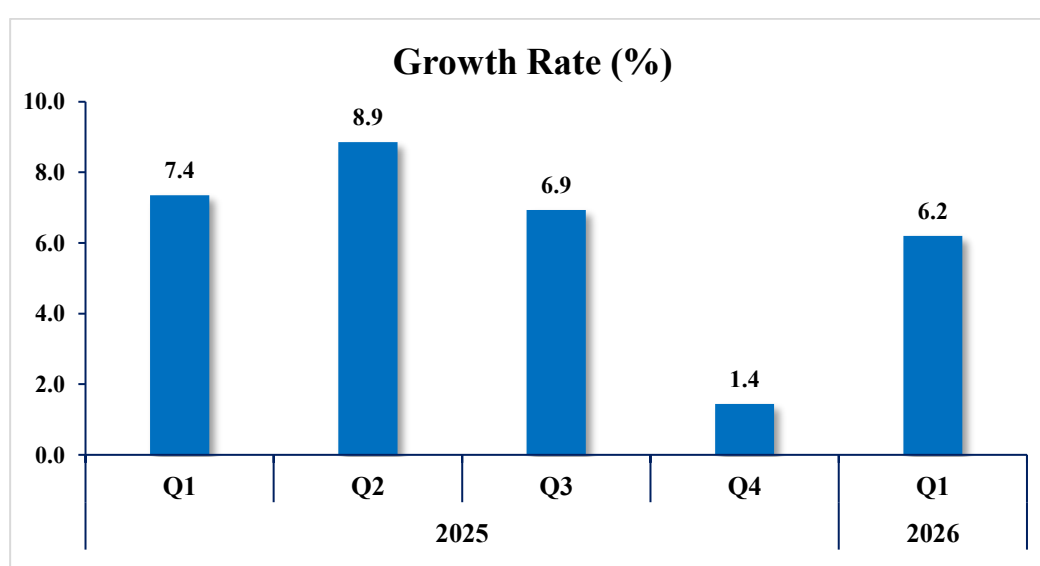
## Performance by Main Sectors

### The Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing

In this quarter, the sector increased by 6.2 percent compare to corresponding quarter of 2025. This is due to the increase in Fishing by 7.0 percent, Crops Production 6.5 percent, Livestock decrease by 5.0 percent and Forestry 4.3 percent.

At current prices, Agriculture, Forestry & Fishing sector was valued at TZS 525 billion in Q1 2026, accounting for about 22.5 percent to the total GVA.

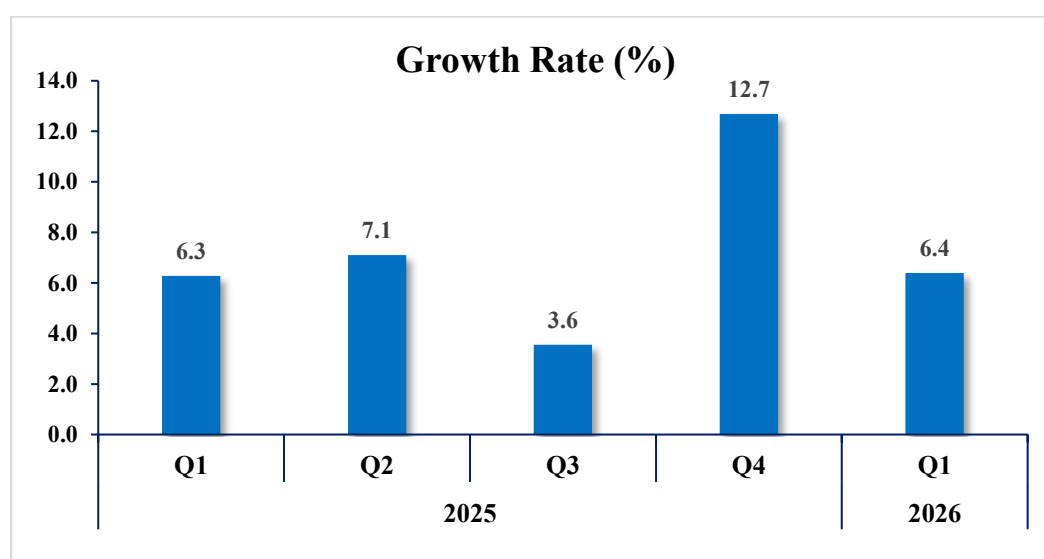

## The Industrial Sector

At constant prices Industrial sector increased by 6.4 percent in Q1 2026 compared to corresponding quarter of 2025. This was mainly attributed to the increase in Mining and Quarrying 8.0 percent, followed by Construction 7.0 percent, Manufacturing 5.4 percent, Water Supply 5.2 percent and Electricity Supply 4.7 percent

At current prices, this sector was valued at TZS 423 billion, contributing 18.1 percent to the total GVA.

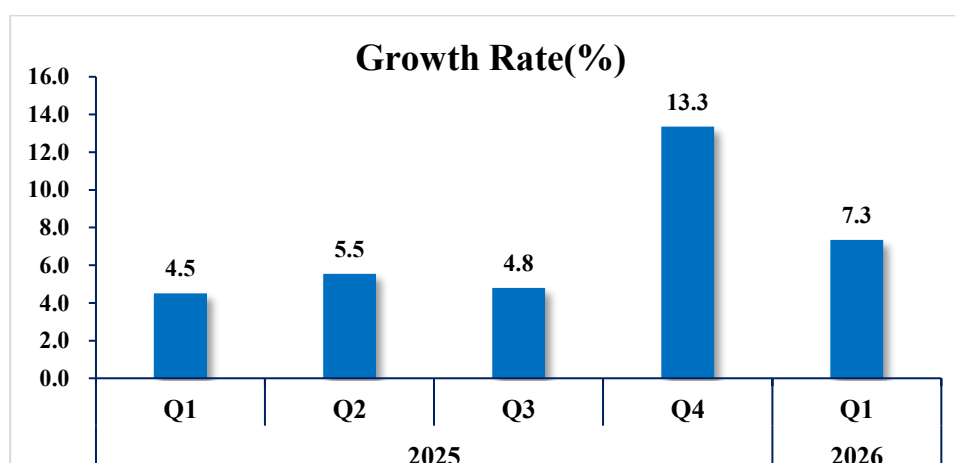

## The Services Sector

At constant prices, the services sector has increased by 7.3 percent compare to corresponding quarter of 2025. The positive growth was attributed to Arts, Entertainment and Recreation (10.8 percent), followed by Accommodation and Food Services (10.2 percent), Other Services (10.2 percent), Human Health and Social Work (8.5 percent), Real Estate (8.4 percent), Transport and Storage (7.9 percent), Wholesale and Retail Trade (7.2 percent), and Education (6.6 percent), among others.

At current prices, the services sector was valued at TZS 1,257 billion and contributed 53.8 percent to the total GVA in Q1 2026.

## Introduction

*The compilation of national accounts statistics is a dynamic process and therefore needs to adapt to reflect a variety of measures and indicators consistent with developments and structural changes in the economy over a period. It is therefore expected that revisions and updates are made to the historical series on a quarterly or annual basis as new data sources are brought into the model and as various benchmarks and assumptions are validated and updated.*
