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TOURISM STATISTICAL RELEASE FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY, 2017

1. Introduction

Information on the number of visitors, their nationality and age distribution are among the important economic indicators. Tourism industry has contributed significantly to the Zanzibar's economy and it is therefore necessary that such information is made available on a timely manner. This release reports on arrivals of foreign visitors. Detailed information on the age and sex distribution; mode of travel; nationality and regional distribution; and purpose of travel of visitors are also provided. The information was captured using the Arrival Declaration cards on visitors who entered Zanzibar through both the airport and sea ports.

2. Definition and Concepts

Tourist: refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited. (According to the United Nations World Tourism Organization -UNWTO).

Visitor¹: refer to any person travelling to place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

This release categories visitor into four groups in term of mode of transport:

- (i) International flight – comprising of tourists entered the country direct from abroad;
- (ii) Domestic flight – comprising of tourists entered Zanzibar via Tanzania Mainland;
- (iii) Cruise ship – comprising of visitors (**excursionist**) entered Zanzibar by cruise ship; and
- (iv) Sea ferries – comprising of tourists entered Zanzibar by using local sea boats.

¹ Visitors are classified as tourists if they spend the night away from home

3. Key findings

January, 2017 recorded **40,938** visitors which is an increase of **29.07** percent compared to **31,717** visitors reported in January 2016. Europeans remain as the largest source of visitors to Zanzibar tourism. Almost three quarters (**73.3** percent) of all visitors entered Zanzibar in January, 2017 were from Europe. In country wise, Italians continue to dominate the Tourism market by accounting **18.9** percent of all visitors entered in January, followed by German (**8.0** percent) and British (**7.5** percent) while New Zealand recorded the least (**0.2** percent). Other performances are as shown in the table 1.

The data from table 2 shows that **34,628** visitors entered Zanzibar through Airport, among them **28,061** visitors came by international flights and **6,567** by domestic flights. The remaining **6,310** visitors entered through seaport whereby **1,024** are day visitors (excursionist) and **5,286** entered by boat from Tanzania Mainland.

Information on the purpose of visit (Table 3) shows that, in January 2017, a majority of visitors **40,226 (98.3** percent) were in Zanzibar for holidays compared with only **549 (1.3** percent) and **32 (0.1** percent) of visitors who were in Zanzibar for 'visiting friend and relatives' and 'business and conference' respectively.

Table 4 shows that in January, 2017 there were **18,198 (44.5** percent) males and **22,740 (55.5** percent) female visitors. Comparing to the previous month, males decreased by **1.9** percent while females decreased by **10.2** percent.

The ages of the visitors were categorized into three broad groups: those younger than 15 years, 15 to 64 years, and 65 years and older. The overall results presented in Table 5 show that **1,953 (4.8** percent) visitors were aged less than 15 years; **35,030 (85.6** percent) were aged 15 and 64 years; and **3,955 (9.7** percent) were aged 65 years and older.

Table 6 shows that majority of the arrivals (**24.1** percent) stayed in the country for seven days and **23.8** percent stayed for six days. Only one percent (1 percent) of the arrival stayed more than a month. The overall average length of stay for tourists in January, 2017 was almost 8 nights.

The number of visitors from emerging market including Poland, China, India, Ukraine, Russia, and Israel shows a remarkable growth as shown in table 7.

The number of visitors from emerging market shows a remarkable growth of more than hundred percent (**116.0** percent) compared with corresponding month in 2016 and a slight decrease of **1.2** percent compared with previous month. With the exception of India, the remaining emerging countries show the growth compared to the corresponding month in 2016. Comparing with previous month, India and Israel show a decrease while the remaining countries portray the growth (Table 8).

The total of **532,487** bed-spaces was available in January 2017. Out of these bed-spaces, an estimate of **319,310** hotel-beds were sold during that month representing a bed occupancy rate of **60.0** percent.(Table 9).
