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TOURISM STATISTICAL RELEASE FOR MAY, 2017

1. Introduction

Information on the number of visitors, their nationality and age distribution are among the important economic indicators. Tourism industry has contributed significantly to the Zanzibar's economy and it is therefore necessary that such information is made available on a timely manner. This release reports on arrivals of foreign visitors. Detailed information on the age and sex distribution; mode of travel; nationality and regional distribution; and purpose of travel of visitors are also provided. The information was captured using the Arrival Declaration cards on visitors who entered Zanzibar through both the airport and sea ports.

2. Definition and Concepts

Tourist: refers to any person travelling to a place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than 12 months and whose main purpose of the trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited. (According to the United Nations World Tourism Organization -UNWTO)

Visitor: refer to any person travelling to place other than that of his/her usual environment for less than twelve months and whose main purpose of trip is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the place visited.

Visitors are classified as tourists if they spend the night away from home.

This release categories visitor into four groups in term of mode of transport:

- (i) International flight – comprising of visitors entered the country direct from abroad;
- (ii) Domestic flight – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar via Tanzania Mainland;
- (iii) Cruise ship – comprising of visitors (**excursionist**) entered Zanzibar by cruise ship; and
- (iv) Sea ferries – comprising of visitors entered Zanzibar by using local sea boats.

3. Key findings

About **15,696** visitors entered Zanzibar in May, 2017 which is an increase of 15 percent compared to corresponding month in May 2016 and a decrease of 25.3 percent compared to previous month. Europeans remain as the largest source of visitors to Zanzibar tourism. About Forty Eight (48.4 percent) of all visitors entered Zanzibar in May, 2017 were from Europe. In country wise, German (1,672) continue to dominate the Tourism market by accounting 10.7 percent of all visitors entered in May, followed by South African 10.5 percent and British (10.2 percent) while New Zealand recorded the least (0.3 percent). Other performances are as shown in table 1.

The data from table 2 shows that 12,164 visitors entered Zanzibar through Airport, among them 9,000 visitors came by international flights and 3,164 by domestic flights. The remaining 3,532 visitors entered through seaport.

Generally, Zanzibar has received **147,123** visitors from January to May 2017 which is an increase of **19.3** percent compared to the corresponding months January - May, 2016. Almost 66.1 percent of all visitors were from Europe. In country wise, Italy (**14.2** percent) is a leading market for the first five months to Zanzibar tourism market. About **123,482** visitors entered through airport which is equivalent to **83.9** percent while the remaining **23,641** visitors entered through seaport that accounting **16.1** percent (Table 3).

Information on the purpose of visit (Table 4) shows that, in May 2017, a majority of visitors 15,047 (95.87 percent) were in Zanzibar for holidays compared with only 521 (3.32 percent) and 50 (0.32 percent) of visitors who were in Zanzibar for 'visiting friend and relatives' and 'business and conference' respectively.

Table 5 shows that in May, 2017 there were 6,619 (42.2 percent) males and 9,077 (57.8 percent) female visitors. Comparing to the previous month males and females decreased by 29.1 percent and 22.2 percent respectively.

The ages of the visitors were categorized into three broad groups: those younger than 15 years, 15 to 64 years, and 65 years and older. The overall results presented in Table 6 show that 509 (3.2 percent) visitors were aged less than 15 years; 14,217 (90.6 percent) were aged 15 and 64 years and 970 (6.2 percent) were aged 65 years and older.

Table 7 shows that majority of the visitors (24.8 percent) stayed in the country for seven days. Only one percent (1.0 percent) of visitors stayed for more than a month. The overall average intended length of stay for visitors in May, 2017 was Eight (8) nights.

The number of visitors from emerging markets for the month of May increased by 44.7 percent compared to corresponding month in May, 2016 and decrease by 50.6 percent compared to previous month. Visitors from Poland have shown a notable increase of more than seventy five percent compared to corresponding month but decreased by 22.8 percent compared to previous month. Other performance are shown in Table 8.

The total of **532,487** bed-spaces was available in May 2017. Out of these bed-spaces, an estimate of **116,916** hotel-beds were sold during that month representing a bed occupancy rate of **21.96** percent.(Table 10).
