1. Balance of Trade

Balance of Trade showed a deficit of TZS 67,124.9 million in October 2021, increased by 21.6 percent compared to the corresponding month of 2020 and by more than hundred percent compared with the previous month. Trade ratio decreased from 63.5 percent in September 2021 to 21.5 percent in October 2021. (Table 1).

2. Exports Statistics

October 2021 recorded a total exports value of TZS 18,421.2 million, increased by more than one hundred percent compared to October 2020 and decreased by 67.1 percent compared to previous month. Food and live animals section contributed 94.5 percent (TZS 17,415.7 million) of the total exports in October 2021 (table 2).



3. Exports by Top Five Partner in October 2021

The top five trading partners for exported goods in the October 2021 accounted 89.6 percent of the total value of exported goods. Major export destination was Singapore that accounted 50.6 percent (TZS 9,320.2 million) of the total export in October 2021(Figure 1).

4. Imports Statistics

October 2021 recorded a total import value of TZS 85,546.1 million, which increased by 46.0 percent compared to October 2020 and decreased by 3.0 percent compared to previous month.

Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials section contributed 26.8 percent (TZS 22,883.7 million) of the total value imported followed by Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (25.8 percent). The performances of other sections are as shown in table 3.

5. Import by Broad Economic Categories (BEC)

Imported value of consumer goods for October 2021 was TZS 24,383.4 million which increased by more than hundred percent compared to the corresponding month 2020 and by 50.3 percent compared to previous month.

Imports value of capital goods was TZS 20,085.9 million which increased by 10.8 with corresponding month of 2020 and decreased by 19.5 percent compared to the previous month.

Imported value of intermediary goods was TZS 41,076.8 million which increased by 39.4 percent compared to corresponding month of 2020 and decreased by 12.7 percent compared to previous month (Table 4).


