ZANZIBAR CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (ZCPI) FOR JANUARY 2023

ANNUAL HEADLINE INFLATION RATE RECORDED 8.35 PERCENT

The Inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Zanzibar for the 12 months to January 2023 increased to 8.35 percent from 8.09 percent register in December 2022. This was mainly driven by the increased in the prices of commodities under; Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate by 11.31 percent in January 2023. The overall Index increased to 103.65 in January 2023 compared to 95.67 recorded in January 2022 (**Table 1**).

ANNUAL FOOD AND NON-FOOD INFLATION RATES

Annual Inflation Rate for food is 11.58 percent for the year ended January 2023 compared to 12.71 percent recorded for the year ended December 2022. The overall index for food increased to 106.24 in January 2023 from 95.21 recorded in January 2022, while overall index for non-food increased to 101.89 in January 2023 compared to 96.00 in January 2022. Annual inflation rate for non-food 1inreased to 6.13 percent in January 2023 compared to 4.93 percent in December 2022 (**Table 2**). Products contribute to increase for Annual inflation rate were Thailand Rice (11.5%), Mbeya Rice (58.2%), Jasmin Rice (27.6%), Flatbread (13.7%), Wheat Flour (27.1%), Maize Flour (53.8%), Green Cooking Bananas (29.9%), White Sugar (19.0%), Kerosene (50.9%), Diesel (23.8%) and Petrol (23.2%) (**Table 3**).

MONTHLY HEADLINE INFLATION IN JANUARY 2023

During January 2023 the monthly headline inflation rate is increased to 1.71 percent compared to 0.75 percent recorded for the month ended December 2022. The monthly Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate for the month ended January 2023 is increased to 2.22 percent compared to 1.67 percent for the month ended December 2022 (**Table 1**). The products that contribute monthly inflation rate to increase are Thailand Rice (18.6%), Mbeya Rice (3.4%), Jasmin Rice (10.7%), Green Cooking Bananas (6.1%) and White Sugar (5.3%). (**Table 3**).




Chart 1: Zanzibar Inflation Rate from January 2021 – January 2023

Explanatory Note

The CPI measures the average percentage changes over time (between two time periods) in the prices of a "basket" of consumer goods and services acquired by households (the market basket) in Zanzibar. The Zanzibar CPI covers prices of 398 items collected in 670 outlets in Unguja and Pemba urban Centers. The goods and services included in the ZCPI basket are classified according to the UN COICOP (Classification of Individual Consumption According by Purpose) with 13 divisions.

The ZCPI weights are based on both monetary and non-momentary expenditures relating to consumption for households in Zanzibar for the 2019/20 Household Budget Survey (HBS). The weight is based on expenditures of both urban and rural households. Both base price and index has reference period of July 2022.

The computation of indices at elementary level based on geometric mean of the price relative while at higher level the Laspeyres formula was to compute the aggregate indices.
