ZANZIBAR CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (ZCPI) FOR AUGUST 2025

ANNUAL HEADLINE INFLATION RATE RECORDED 3.88 PERCENT

The Inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Zanzibar for the 12 months to August 2025 decreased to 3.88 percent from 4.05 percent registered in July 2025. Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate decrease to 4.76 percent in August 2025 compared to 4.87 percent in July 2025. The overall Index increased to 117.01 in August 2025 compared to 112.64 recorded in August 2024 (Table 1).

ANNUAL FOOD AND NON-FOOD INFLATION RATES

Annual Inflation Rate for food decreased to 4.17 percent for the year ended August 2025 compared to 4.27 percent recorded for the year ended July 2025. The overall index for food increased to 128.34 in August 2025 from 123.20 recorded in August 2024, while Annual inflation rate for non-food decrease to 3.65 percent in August 2025 compared to 3.88 percent in July 2025, overall index for non-food increased to 109.29 in August 2025 compared to 105.44 in August 2024, (Table 2). Products contribute to decrease annual inflation rate were Thailand Rice 11.01%, Basmat Rice 1.16%, Jasmin Rice 3.93%, Wheat Flour 0.18%, Maize Flour 0.84%, Fish 5.67%, Brown Sugar 16.17%, White Sugar 15.70%, Kerosene 6.25% Petrol 2.74%, and Diesel 5.62% (Table 3).

MONTHLY HEADLINE INFLATION IN AUGUST 2025

During August 2025 the monthly headline inflation rate decreased to 0.13 percent compared to 0.18 percent recorded for the month ended July 2025. The monthly Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate for the month ended August 2025 increased to 0.79 percent compared to 0.05 percent for the month ended July 2025 (**Table 1**).

The products that contribute to decrease monthly inflation rate are Mbeya Rice 0.15%, Sunflower Oil 3.03%, Edible Cooking Oils (OKI) 1.91% Yellow Cooking Banana 1.06%, Brown Sugar 2.72%, White Sugar 1.28% and Petrol 0.60% (Table3).

Chart 1: Zanzibar Inflation Rate from August 2023 – August 2025





Chart 2: Zanzibar Inflation Rate for Food, Nonfood and All Items from August 2024 – August 2025



Explanatory Note

The CPI measures the average percentage changes over time (between two time periods) in the prices of a "basket" of consumer goods and services acquired by households (the market basket) in Zanzibar. The Zanzibar CPI covers prices of 398 items collected in 670 outlets in Unguja and Pemba urban Centers. The goods and services included in the ZCPI basket are classified according to the UN COICOP (Classification of Individual Consumption According by Purpose) with 13 divisions.

The ZCPI weights are based on both monetary and non-momentary expenditures relating to consumption for households in Zanzibar for the 2019/20 Household Budget Survey (HBS). The weight is based on expenditures of both urban and rural households. Both base price and index has reference period of July 2022.

The computation of indices at elementary level based on geometric mean of the price relative while at higher level the Laspeyres formula was used to compute the aggregate indices.
