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QUARTERLY STATISTICAL RELEASE ON MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION SECOND QUARTER - 2025

An Overview

This report presents result of Industrial Production Survey for the second quarter of the year 2025. The information presented in this report is in quantity and value of the products for the selected commodities in the manufacturing industry.

Objective

The primary objective of the quarterly survey of Industrial production is to give timely information on short – term development of the industrial sector in Zanzibar. The information will be useful to planners, decision makers and all other parties interested in studying the country's industrial sector.

Scope and Coverage

The survey is limited to manufacturing industry and covers almost all manufacturing establishments with large share in this sector (selected commodities). According to 2008 and 2012 Industrial census results, it contributes more than 85 percent of the total manufacturing gross output; consequently, the realized output may be used as a reliable estimate for the industrial sector. The small-scale establishments with substantial output were also included. They were less than 10 percent of the total number of establishments covered.

Methodology

This QSIP report is limited to quarterly surveys of ‘selected commodities’ industrial products. As such, and to the nature of manufacturing activities in Zanzibar its scope is highly limited to only few products.

Data collection is done on quarterly basis. The information collected is in quantity and value of the selected commodities produced monthly starting from the quarter of the year targeted. The survey is conducted on a regular basis and report is usually out within six weeks after the end of the quarter.

Summary Results

In general, the total value of selected commodities for the second quarter of the year 2025 was decreased from 22,200 million TZS to 14,528 million TZS, the decreases were due to the decrease in manufacturing of grain mill product, manufacturing of sugar product and manufacturing of other food product; and no production in Manufacture of macaroni, noodles, couscous and similar farinaceous products in the second quarter of the year 2025 (Table 1.4).

The manufacture of grain mill products has the highest percentage share, it covers about 78.65 percent of the total value of production, followed by manufacture of beverages and sugar product with 10.24 percent and 9.13 percent respectively (Table 1.4).

The production in manufacture of grain mill products was decreased by 15.3 percent from 16,902 tons in the first quarter of the year 2024 to 14,316 tons in the second quarter of the year 2025. Where, manufacturing of bakery products was increased from 64,001 thousand in the first quarter of the year 2025 to 67,241 thousand in the second quarter of the year 2025.

The manufacture of sugar product was decrease from 886 tons in the first quarter of the year 2025 to 663 tons in the second quarter of the year 2025. Similarly, the manufacture of other food products n.e.c in the second quarter were decrease from 9,000 Kg in the first quarter to 8,712 Kg in the second quarter of the year 2025. Whilst, there was no production in manufacture of macaroni, noodles, couscous and similar farinaceous products for the second quarter of the year 2025 while the production was 20,000 Kg in the first quarter of the year 2025.

The production in manufacturing of wearing apparel, except fur apparel was increased from 1,530 pieces to 1,583 pieces which is equivalent to the increase of 0.35 percent from the first quarter of the year 2025 to the second quarter of the year 2025. The production in manufacturing of pharmaceutical, medical chemical and botanic products was increased by 2.0 percent from 4,789 kg in the first quarter of the year 2025 to 4,884 kg in the second quarter of the year 2025. The production in manufacturing of jewellery and related articles was increased by 10.6 percent (**Table 1.3 and 1.4**).

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
