ZANZIBAR CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (ZCPI) FOR AUGUST 2024

ANNUAL HEADLINE INFLATION RATE RECORDED 5.12 PERCENT The Inflation as measured by the Consumer Price Index for Zanzibar for the 12 months to August 2024 decreased to 5.12 percent from 5.26 percent registered in July 2024. This was mainly driven by the decreased in the prices of commodities under; Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate decrease by 8.69 percent in August 2024 compared to 8.96 percent in July 2024. The overall Index increased to 112.64 in August 2024 compared to 107.15 recorded in August 2023 (Table 1).

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ANNUAL FOOD AND NON-FOOD INFLATION RATES

Annual Inflation Rate for food is decreased to 8.88 percent for the year ended August 2024 compared to 9.16 percent recorded for the year ended July 2024. The overall index for food increased to 123.20 in August 2024 from 113.16 recorded in August 2023, while Annual inflation rate for non-food decrease to 2.32 percent in August 2024 compared to 2.37 percent in July 2024, overall index for non-food increased to 105.44 in August 2024 compared to 103.06 in August 2023, (Table 2). Products contribute to decrease annual inflation rate were Mbeya Rice 8.7%, Basmat Rice 2.9%, Wheat Flour 5.6%, Maize Flour 8.3%, Edible cooking Oils (OKI) 3.3%, Yellow cooking Banana 15.2%, Green cooking banana 25.4% and Brown Sugar 0.5% (Table 3).

MONTHLY HEADLINE INFLATION IN AUGUST 2024

During August 2024 the monthly headline inflation rate is increased to 0.30 percent compared to 0.22 percent recorded for the month ended July 2024. The monthly Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages inflation rate for the month ended August 2024 increased to percent 0.89 compared to 0.15 percent for the month ended July 2024 (**Table 1**).


The products that contribute monthly inflation rate to increase are Fish 8.1%, Edible Cooking Oil 2.8% and Diesel 6.0% (Table3).

Chart 2: Zanzibar Inflation Rate for Food, Nonfood and All Items from August 2022 – August 2024






Chart 2: Zanzibar Inflation Rate for Food, Nonfood and All Items from August 2023 – August 2024

Explanatory Note

The CPI measures the average percentage changes over time (between two time periods) in the prices of a "basket" of consumer goods and services acquired by households (the market basket) in Zanzibar. The Zanzibar CPI covers prices of 398 items collected in 670 outlets in Unguja and Pemba urban Centers. The goods and services included in the ZCPI basket are classified according to the UN COICOP (Classification of Individual Consumption According by Purpose) with 13 divisions.

The ZCPI weights are based on both monetary and non-momentary expenditures relating to consumption for households in Zanzibar for the 2019/20 Household Budget Survey (HBS). The weight is based on expenditures of both urban and rural households. Both base price and index has reference period of July 2022.

The computation of indices at elementary level based on geometric mean of the price relative while at higher level the Laspeyres formula was used to compute the aggregate indices.
